HPCL is a Government of India Enterprise under the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas (MOP&NG), Government of India. It is engaged in Refining, Storage, Distribution—and marketing of Petroleum products and operates Refineries at Mumbai and Vishakhapatnam and has vast marketing network consisting of Zonal offices, Regional offices, Terminals, Pipeline networks Aviation Service stations, LPG Botting Plants and Inland Relay Depots etc. spread across India.

HPCL, Refinery Division proposes to engage the following Apprentices at Mumbai Refinery as per provision of Apprentices Act, 1961 and the Rules thereof.

DURATION OF TRAINING:

- 1. Engineering Graduate Apprentice 1 Year
- 2. Technician Diploma Apprentice Trainees 1 Year

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR BOTH Graduate Apprentices Engineering & Technician Diploma Apprentice Trainees:

- Only Indian nationals are eligible to apply.
- Candidates living in Mumbai Metropolitan Region (Mumbai, Mumbai City, Mumbai Suburban, Thane, Palghar, Navi Mumbai, and Raigad) only shall apply for apprenticeship training at Mumbai Refinery of HPCL.
- Only the candidates registered and approved on the National Apprenticeship Training scheme (NATS) web portal and by Board of Apprenticeship Training (BOAT) will be considered for selection to undergo Apprenticeship Training.
- Engineering Graduates in Civil/Mechanical/ Electrical/ Chemical/ Electrical & Electronics/Instrumentation/Computer Science/ IT streams who have completed Engineering Graduation after 01-02-2021 onwards are eligible to apply. Candidates passed out prior to 01-02-2021 are not eligible for apprenticeship training.
- Technician Diploma Apprentice Trainees in Civil/Mechanical/ Electrical/ Chemical/ Electrical & Electronics/Instrumentation streams who have completed Diploma Engineering after 01-02-2021 onwards are eligible to apply. Candidates passed out prior to 01-02-2021 are not eligible for apprenticeship training.
- Candidates belonging to General/OBC-NC/ EWS category must have 60% aggregate whereas candidates belonging to SC/ST/PwBD (VH/HH/OH) must have 50% aggregate marks in all years/semesters in qualifying examination.
- Calculation of Percentage: The degree percentage as provided by university/college will be considered or where CGPA/GPA or letter grade in a qualifying degree is awarded, equivalent percentage of marks should be indicated in the application form as per norms adopted by University/Institute. Please also obtain a certificate to this effect from University / Institute which shall be required at the time of interview. In case where above percentage/conversion is not available then the percentage marks shall be arrived at by dividing the total marks obtained by the candidate in all the qualifying subjects in all the semester(s)/year(s) by aggregating maximum marks. The fraction of percentage so arrived will be ignored i.e. 49.99% will be treated as less than 50%.







- All the qualifications specified above should be recognized by Board of Technical Education/ UGC/AICTE.
- Age Limit: Minimum 18 years and maximum 25 years as on 01-02-2023. Max. Age relaxation by 5 yrs. for SC/ST, 3 yrs. for OBC and 10 yrs. for PwBD (VH/HH/OH) Candidates.
- Relaxations in Eligibility criterion, Age and Reservations for SC, ST, OBCNC, and PwBD (Persons with benchmarked disabilities – with degree of disability 40% or above) will be as per Government Guidelines / Apprentices Act, 1961.
- Candidates who have been engaged previously as Apprentice or are undergoing Apprenticeship training elsewhere and have an apprenticeship contract with any other organization under the Apprentices Act, 1961 on the NATS Portal are not eligible to apply. In case of any existing apprenticeship contract with any organization may lead to rejection of the application.
- Candidates who have got work experience of one year or more are not eligible to apply.
- Candidates applying for HPCL on NATS Portal after 12-02-2023 will not be considered.

SELECTION METHODOLOGY

- Candidates fulfilling all the above mentioned eligibility criteria will be called for Interview. Management reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates to be called for Interview which will be tentatively scheduled in the month of February 2023.
- The merit list will be drawn basis the scores in the INTERVIEW and the academic results of Engineering / Diploma.
- Final offer for Apprenticeship Training would be subject to clearing the Medical Test
 as per HPCL standards and submission of all documents / certificates towards proof
 of Age, Qualifications, Caste, Medical certificate of PwBD and medical fitness etc.., as
 may be applicable.

PROCESS TO APPLY FOR APPRENTICESHIP AT HPCL

 Once candidates have enrolled themselves on NATS Portal, candidates to log onto NATS Portal using their USER ID/Email ID and password.

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- Once logged in, on the home page, candidates have to click on "ESTABLISHMENT REQUESTS" and select option "Find Establishment" from drop down menu.
- Once candidates click on "Find Establishment", the page appears with two "Search Criterions", i.e. Options to search by 1) Preferences and 2) Establishment Name.
- Among the search criterion options select Establishment Name, candidates need to type Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited and click on option "Search".
- Once candidates click on search, apprentice vacancies at Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited appears. Candidates need to Click on establishment name "HINDUSTAN PETROLEUM CORPORATION LTD. (MUMBAI REFINERY) have establishment ID "WMHMCS000015" and select "Apply" button.
- Once candidates click on "Apply" button a message appears as given below "Successfully applied for the training position".
- Before applying candidates must ensure that all their profile details (Caste, Educational Background, Personal credentials etc.) along with aggregate percentage (refer calculation of percentage in eligibility requirements) are appearing correctly in their application. HPCL will not make any revisions/corrections in the data submitted by candidates. Candidates are requested to contact their respective BOAT office in case of any corrections.
- The candidates can confirm if they applied for the establishment by checking under the tab Establishment Requests.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE

- HPCL does not give any commitment/assurance on providing permanent/temporary employment to Apprentices on successful completion of Apprenticeship period.
- Furnishing of wrong/false information will lead to disqualification and HPCL will not be
 responsible for any of the consequences of furnishing such wrong/false information. If
 any of the above discrepancies w.r.t to eligibility parameters, furnishing of wrong
 intimation and or suppressing of any material fact detected/notice even after
 engagement, his/her training will be liable for termination without any further notice.
 Canvassing in any form during any stage of engagement process will lead to
 cancellation candidature.
- Apprentice will be placed for training in our Refinery at Mumbai only and will be bound by all rules/ regulations of working conditions applicable.







GENERAL CONDITIONS

- The engagement of Apprentices will be governed by the Apprentices Act 1961 / Apprentices Amendment Act, 1973 and Rules thereof.
- The engagement as Apprentice Trainees for Engineering Graduates and Technician Diploma Apprentice Trainee will be for a period of ONE YEAR only.
- Candidates selected as Graduate Apprentice Trainee (Engineering) shall be paid monthly stipend of Rs. 25000/- (Rupees Twenty-Five Thousand Only).
- Technician Diploma Apprentice Trainee will be paid monthly stipend of Rs.15000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only).
- The reserved category candidates are required to submit SC/ST/OBC-NC/ EWS and PwBD (VH/HH/OH) certificate/s in the prescribed format application (the formats can be downloaded from our site Downloads>Downloads for Apprentices">www.hpclcareers.com>Downloads>Downloads for Apprentices)
- Candidates must also ensure that the name of their caste/community and its spelling
 in their caste/community certificate should be exactly as mentioned in the lists notified
 by the central government from time to time (for OBCNC category list of castes
 recognized by the Govt. of India as OBC castes in the central list is available on the
 site http://www.ncbc.nic.in, for ST category the list of castes for each state is available
 on the site www.ncst.nic.in and for SC category the list of castes for each state is
 available on the site http://www.socialjustice.nic.in). A certificate containing any
 variation in the caste name will not be accepted. Further the OBC certificate should
 also clearly indicate that the candidate does not belong to creamy layer as defined by
 the Government of India.
- The OBC claim of a candidate will be determined in relation to the State (or part of the State) to which his/her father originally belongs. A candidate who has migrated from one State (or part of the State) to another should, therefore, produce an OBC certificate which should have been issued to him/her based on his/her father's OBC certificate from the State to which he (father) originally belongs.
- The OBC candidates who belong to "Creamy Layer" are not entitled for concession admissible to OBC-NC candidates and such candidates will have to indicate their category as Unreserved (UR).







- If the SC/ST/OBC-NC/PwBD certificate has been issued in a language other than English/Hindi, the candidates will be required to submit a self-certified translated copy of the same either in English or Hindi.
- The benefits of reservation under EWS category can be availed upon production of an 'Income and Asset Certificate' valid for Financial Year 2022-23 issued by a Competent Authority based on gross annual income of FY 2021-22 in the format prescribed by Government of India. Candidates are advised to be in possession of "Income and Assets Certificate" as mentioned above issued on or after 01.04.2022 at the time of selection process. 'Income and Asset certificate' shall be submitted by such candidates at the time of selection process (if called). No request for extension of time for production of 'Income & Asset certificate' beyond the said date shall be entertained. Further, their request for consideration under general category will also not be entertained.

NOTE: Candidates are "NOT" Required to submit hard copy of application forms to HPCL. The details filled in the online Registration / application form will be considered final & no changes will be entertained w.r.t personal or any other details later on.

- Interview call letter will be sent over NATS Portal and no hard copy will be sent to the candidates. All communications will be thru the email ID/ Mobile Number provided by the candidates in his/her online application.
- Application with incomplete / wrong particulars will not be considered. The email ID &
 Mobile number provided in online Registration/ application should remain valid for at
 least one year. Candidates must use proper e-mail IDs created in their names.

 Applications with pseudo/fake email IDs will attract appropriate actions under
 the law.
- HPCL will not be responsible for any loss/ non-delivery of email/admit card sent/ any other communication sent, due to invalid/wrong email id or contact number.
- All the details given in the online Registration form will be treated as final & no changes
 will be entertained. Any request for change in category (GEN/SC/ST/OBC-NC/EWS/
 PwBD -[VH/HH/OH]) once filled in the online Registration/Application Form will not be
 considered and accordingly concessions/relaxation applicable will not be extended.
- Depending upon number of applications, HPCL reserves the right to raise the minimum eligibility standards/criteria and modify the selection process.







- HPCL reserves the right to determine the total number of apprentices to be engaged/candidates to be selected at any stage of selection process.
- Management reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates to be called for interview/medical tests without assigning any reason.
- Management reserves the right to raise minimum eligibility standards and to increase/decrease the number of vacancies. Management also reserves the right to cancel/restrict/curtail/enlarge the apprentice engagement process and/or the selection process there under without any further notice and without assigning any reason.
- All the candidates are required to remain updated at each step of the selection process by visiting NATS portal.
